Dear organization:

The University of Wisconsin-Whitewater Tennis Club (UWWTC) offers you the opportunity to ACE OUT AUTISM! on March 14th at the David L. Kachel Fieldhouse on the UW-Whitewater Campus. UWWTC is hosting the event to raise funds for Foundation for Autistic Childhood Education and Support (F.A.C.E.S), a California foundation whose mission is "to enable children with autism to reach their full potential."

Here's how it works:

For a \$5 fee, individuals may purchase 5 tennis balls to serve. We will measure the speed of their serves with a radar gun. At the end of the day, we will choose our top 5 male and top 5 female servers. These individuals will be matched up with a business that has pre-committed to sponsoring a specific dollar amount *per mph*. Each of the 10 servers is given another 5 serves, and their fastest correct serve will be used to calculate the final donation from their corresponding sponsor. **Half** the proceeds from such donations will be donated to F.A.C.E.S. These funds will go towards a playground for a new special-ed pre-school for autistic children that will be inaugurated in January 2009. All donations are 100% tax deductible!

UWWTC invites <u>you</u> to join the Whitewater community in ACE OUT AUTISM! as one of the many businesses who will make a difference in the lives of hundreds of adults and children affected by ASD. **Any \$\$ amount per mile per hour is accepted!** For a rough estimate of your final donation, please consider that the fastest serve speed expected is 100 mph.
